

## **General Range Rules**

Everyone must check-in at the office first

Everyone entering the range and their guardian if applicable, must read and agree to our range rules Assumption of Risk, Indemnification and Release Agreement completely and sign a waiver that RELEASES Gray Smoke Arms and Range, and any personnel FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY FOR PERSONAL INJURY while on the Range property. Gray Smoke Arms and Range is not responsible for personal property.

Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times.

Pregnant and nursing women, people subject to seizures, on prescribed narcotics, require oxygen tanks, or have an existing or at risk medical condition, should consult their physician before entering the range.

Alcohol or illegal substances are not allowed on premise

You are not allowed to be on premise while under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances

All Commands issued by Range Personnel must be immediately obeyed without question.

Range Personnel have the right to inspect any firearms, ammunition, bows, arrows, or other equipment at any time.

All Items brought on premise must be legal

All federal, state, and local laws MUST be obeyed

Trespassing outside of designated areas is not allowed

Closed toe shoes are required on the range.

The safety of yourself and others is priority

Range Personnel reserves the right to reject or refuse anyone access to all facilities

## **Gun Range Specific Rules**

You must know how to safely operate your firearm.

All federal, state, and local firearm laws MUST be obeyed

Holster Draw is not allowed except during approved special events

There is to be NO firing a firearm from the hip except during approved special events. This includes pistol grip shotguns.

You can load as many rounds as you would like, and fire them as fast as you want, as long as you do so safely and accurately.

Eye and Hearing protection required while on or near the range

Always have firearms pointed down range

Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.

Always keep your gun unloaded until you are at the firing line and the range is declared "HOT." Firearms must be safe (unloaded - magazines removed and actions opened) when entering or exiting the range.

Do not fire when someone is down range

Stay off the firing line and away from firearms during a cease-fire or when someone is down range

Do not proceed down range, if anyone is on the firing line.

Immediately stop shooting when anyone calls "Cease firing."

Shooters must check with others to ensure firearms are unloaded, actions open and firearms laid down on the shooting bench before going down range. No one is permitted to handle firearms or stand at the firing line while there is a cold range.

Shooters must check with others to ensure there is no one down range; when the range is declared "HOT" shooters are permitted to commence firing. Only shooters are permitted on the firing line. Shooters may move safe guns to and from the firing line only when the range is "HOT."

Only shoot at designated targets. ALWAYS be absolutely sure that the path to the target and beyond is clear.

Firing a shot on the Range that results in the bullet striking anything other than the target and/or backstop, may result in a repair fine and potentially your removal from the range

You are not allowed to shoot any wildlife or domestic animals on premise

Do not throw any ammunition or empty shells into the trash containers.

No cleaning of firearms or equipment is allowed on the range. No chemical, including solvents and lubricants are to be used on the bench. You must provide your own tools for minor adjustments (sight, etc). The Range cannot provide tools for you to work on your firearm or equipment.

Shoot to your abilities

You may collect your own brass that is inside your area and behind the firing line. Brass from other shooters and all brass that falls in front of the firing line may not be collected.

## **Archery / Throwing Range Specific Rules**

Always keep your arrows pointed down or towards the target

You are not allowed to shoot or throw at any wildlife or domestic animals on premise

Only shoot or throw at designated targets. ALWAYS be absolutely sure that the path to the target and beyond is clear.

Hitting anything other than the target and/or ground, may result in a repair fine and potentially your removal from the range

Do not shoot or throw when someone is down range

Stay off the shooting / throwing line and away from equipment during a cease or when someone is down range

Do not proceed down range, if anyone is on the shooting / throwing line.

Immediately stop shooting or throwing when anyone calls "Cease."

Shooters and Throwers must check with others to ensure equipment is on the bench before going down range. No one is permitted to handle equipment at the shooting/throwing line while there is a cold range.

Shooters/throwers must check with others to ensure there is no one down range; when the range is declared "HOT" shooters and throwers are permitted to commence. Only shooters/throwers are permitted on the shooting/throwing line. Shooters may move safe equipment to and from the shooting/throwing line only when the range is "HOT."

No cleaning of equipment is allowed on the range. No chemical, including solvents and lubricants are to be used on the bench. You must provide your own tools for minor adjustments. The Range cannot provide tools for you to work on your equipment.
